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Oceanview Cabins:

Oceanview cabins on the *Carnival Miracle* are limited and therefore require a deposit of \$300.00 per person to confirm a reservation. These are the only type of cabins that cannot be blocked for the group, so the price is subject to change until a reservation has been made. The second payment noted below will not required for oceanview cabins.

Bus to New York:

Depending upon the size of the group, a bus may be chartered to/from New York City. Information on this will be provided at a later date.

Payment information:

- An initial deposit of \$50.00 per person is due by Decemeber 10, 2011.
(Reservations with 3 or 4 people in one cabin require a deposit of \$300.00 per person.)
- A second payment of \$250.00 per person is due by April 21, 2012.
(This payment is not required for reservations with 3 or 4 people in one cabin.)
- The final payment is due by July 7, 2012.

Cancellation penalties:

Up until July 30, 2012:	\$50.00 per person
July 31 – August 29, 2012:	\$350.00 per person
August 30 – September 14, 2012:	50% penalty
September 15 – September 29, 2012:	75% penalty
September 30, 2012 or after:	Non-refundable

Proof of citizenship:

A **passport** is recommended for this cruise. Although a passport is not required, traveling with one enhances your disembarkation process as delays may be expected upon your return into the U.S. if you do not have one. Additionally, should an emergency arise requiring you to fly home, you will not be able to do so without a passport. If you choose not to travel with a passport, you must travel with an original, state-issued birth certificate and government-issued photo ID.

Please contact Tina if you need information on obtaining a passport.

Travel insurance:

Carnival's Cruise Vacation Protection Plan is available for an additional cost:

- \$95.00 per person for an inside or oceanview cabin
- \$109.00 per person for a balcony cabin

This will provide protection for cancellations for certain specified reasons (such as injury, illness or death affecting you or an immediate family member, job loss, severe weather) as well as trip interruption, trip delay, baggage protection and medical coverage while traveling.
